Board of Director positions are volunteer based. Harbor Point Bylaws Article Seven Miscellaneous, Section 3 states: The Association shall not enter into any contract to pay and shall not pay any salary or other remuneration to any Officer, Director or Committee Member of the Association for their service as such.

#### Clean Up/Burning Information

When the burn ban is OFF property owners can burn on their own property. Residents can burn without a permit but must notify Nonemergency Dispatch at 325-646-2525 first. Provide details of the items to be burned, location, contact name, and cell phone number. The person starting the open burn must always attend to the

fire and have fire suppression equipment available. Be aware there are approved and unapproved materials that can be burned by property owners. Refer to the State of Texas and Brown County for a comprehensive list of materials that are prohibited from open burning, such as oil filters, tires, furniture, and plastics, which must be taken to a recycling center. Be sure you are properly prepared to control the burn. For the safety of the community.

Harbor Point Subdivision is concerned debris piles are a place for rodents, snakes and other unwanted guests such as skunks to settle. Removal keeps our subdivision safe for our residence and community. It also keeps your investment in your property from declining. Our HPOA has restrictions concerning unsightliness. These can be found on the HPOA website

www.harborpointownersassoci ation.net. If you are unable to dispose of open domestic trash piles, scattered trash, brush piles, or grass piles due to physical or financial reasons, please inform the office. We may be able to find assistance to help you. This is a giving community in many ways.

Thank you to everyone who is mowing and cleaning their property this spring. The burn ban is off, and it is a great time to burn any debris. Two owners have recently painted their homes. Thanks for the facelift. We are making progress with removing some of the old derelict structures. You will notice an old trailer was recently removed and a new double wide manufactured home has been installed on the corner of Beachside Drive and Bayside Drive. Thank you, Mr. Tarango! Additional old trailers are scheduled to be removed and replaced shortly. We will be continuing our efforts with those owners whose properties are not in compliance. In April alone, 27 owners were fined due to non-compliance. Unfortunately, more fines are forthcoming. We are reviewing and approving applications on a regular basis. If you have an upcoming project, please get the application to us ahead of time for review.

## **Slow Down**

Activity level around, by or near the subdivision roads is increasing. Whether you are in an ATV, golf cart or your vehicle please obey the speed limit signs. In doing this you can avoid being responsible for a tragic accident that involves injuries to children, adults, pets or possibly yourself. Reduce speed and remain cautious when near children playing, residents walking, volunteers working on the roads, or volunteers picking up trash within the subdivision. Racing 4 wheelers needs to happen off the subdivision roads. Please note it is not just youngsters speeding on 4 wheelers, many adults are guilty of joy riding at dangerous speeds.

### Restriction 16

If you are a property owner, please read, understand and Restriction 16. Most owners are doing a great job keeping their pets safe, secure and are responsible for their pets. For those few who demonstrate they have difficulty with pet ownership responsibilities it may have a costly outcome or a tragic one. No one wants to be approached by an unfamiliar or aggressive dog running loose or a dog that chases ATV's, golf carts, cars, people or randomly invades residence yards.
